GENERAL INFORMATION:

CLEARTANK is a spray system cleaner specially developed for removing pesticide residues, pigments, surfactants, and other contaminants from spray equipment. Its balanced formulation combines alkalinizing agents, surfactants, dispersants, and corrosion inhibitors to clean tanks, hoses, filters, and nozzles, while helping protect equipment against oxidation and cross-contamination. Regular use of CLEARTANK helps ensure operational safety, extends equipment life, and reduces the risk of pesticide carryover between applications.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Always read and follow all label directions before use. Wear protective gloves, goggles, and long-sleeved clothing when handling the concentrated product.

RECOMMENDED RATES:

RESIDUE TYPE	RATE OF CLEARTANK
Heavy (persistent residues, oils, stubborn deposits)	0.3% v/v ou 38 fl. oz. per 100 gallons.
Light (routine maintenance cleaning)	0.1% v/v ou 13 fl. oz. per 100 gal.

Use the higher rate for heavy cleaning, or when switching between different types of pesticides.

Use the lower rate for routine or frequent maintenance.

MIXING AND CLEANING PROCEDURE

- Drain the spray tank completely and remove visible deposits.
- Pre-rinse with 50–100 gallons of clean water, circulating through the nozzles.
- Fill the tank half full with clean water, add CLEARTANK at the recommended rate, and complete filling while maintaining agitation.
- Circulate the solution through the entire system for 15–20 minutes, spraying part of the solution through the nozzles.
- Remove nozzles, screens, and strainers. Soak separately in a bucket containing diluted CLEARTANK solution. Rinse thoroughly and reinstall.
- Flush the system again with clean water until completely rinsed.
- Repeat the cleaning procedure if residues persist.

Store this product in a cool, dry and well-ventilated place, at temperatures between 5°C and 30°C (41°F and 86°F). Keep the container tightly closed when not in use and always store it locked up and out of the reach of children. Avoid exposure to direct sunlight and sources of heat or ignition. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.
