CROPS:

ELEKTRA can be applied on a broad spectrum of crops, including but not limited to:

- Row Crops: Corn, Soybeans, Cotton, Rice, Wheat, Cereals/Small Grains, Sugar Beets, Sunflower.
- Specialty Crops: Citrus, Grapes, Apples, Peanuts, Potatoes, Beans, Berries, Vegetables, Cucurbits, Ornamentals, Nursery Crops, Sod/Turf.

COMPATIBILITY:

ELEKTRA is compatible with most agricultural pesticides, fertilizers, and biological products. However, a jar test is recommended before mixing with unfamiliar products to ensure physical compatibility.

Harmful if swallowed. Causes skin and serious eye irritation. Avoid breathing mist, vapors, or spray. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Do not eat, drink, or smoke when using this product. Wear protective gloves, long-sleeved clothing, and eye/face protection during mixing and application.
